Claret wool	Scalloped Heart Border, Center, & Leaf	7" x 8"
Red wool	Heart	5" x 6"
Pink Wool	Circle	1.5" x 1.5"
Beige Wool	2 Leaves	2" x 2"
Red Lacey	Cotton Background	7" x 8"
Black Wool	Backing	7" x 8"

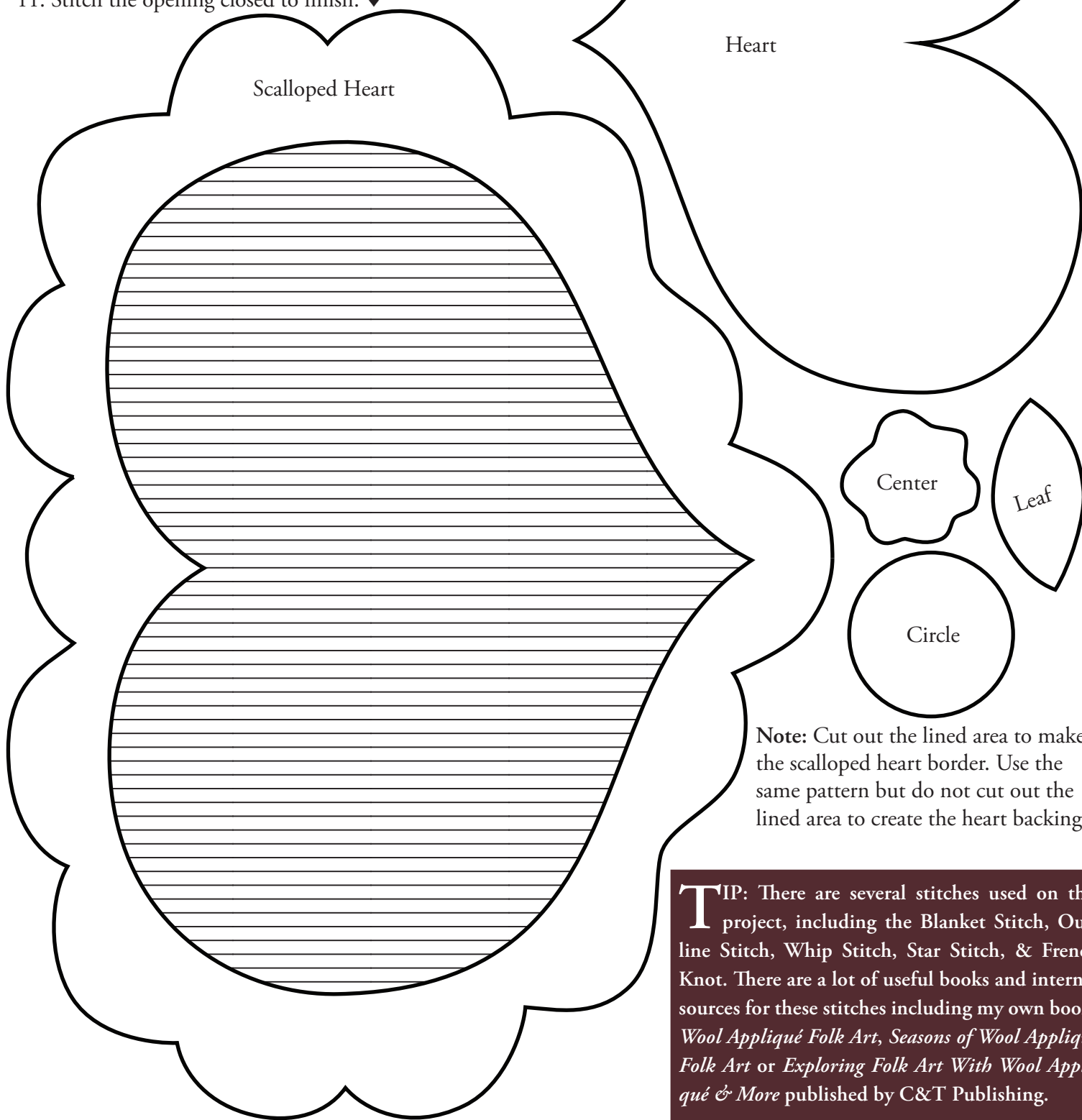
other supplies

DMC™ Floss #841 #869 #3371
(use 2 strands of floss)
Chenille #24 Needles
Paper & Fabric Scissors
Freezer Paper
Wool scraps or other stuffing

PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Trace the patterns onto freezer paper and cut out the patterns on the line.
2. Press the freezer paper patterns onto the wool with your iron on the "wool" setting.
3. Cut out the wool shapes.
4. Peel the freezer paper patterns from the wool.

5. Blanket stitch the wool pieces to the red heart first and embellish as desired.
6. Pin the scalloped heart wool piece onto the cotton rectangle and stitch into place.
7. Trim the cotton fabric so that it lays underneath the outside edge of the scalloped heart.
8. Pin the red heart to the cotton fabric and stitch into place.
9. Steam press the wooly from the back.
10. Pin the backing and the finished front wooly together and blanket stitch around the outside, leaving a small space to stuff the heart with.
11. Stitch the opening closed to finish. ♥

Note: Cut out the lined area to make the scalloped heart border. Use the same pattern but do not cut out the lined area to create the heart backing.

TIP: There are several stitches used on this project, including the Blanket Stitch, Outline Stitch, Whip Stitch, Star Stitch, & French Knot. There are a lot of useful books and internet sources for these stitches including my own books *Wool Applique Folk Art*, *Seasons of Wool Applique Folk Art* or *Exploring Folk Art With Wool Applique & More* published by C&T Publishing.
