## Wooly Christmas Greeting

## **Materials**

Black wool (Envelope) 8" x 8" Festive cotton (Lining) 6.5" x 6.5" Light chip board (Insert) 4" x 5" Ribbon 7" Button

## **Supplies**

DMC Floss #841 & #869 Freezer Paper Needles Chenille #24 Pins


## Instructions

- 1. Trace the patterns onto freezer paper.
- 2. Cut out the freezer paper patterns.
- 3. Press the freezer paper patterns onto the wool/cotton with your iron on the "wool" setting.
- 4. Cut out the wool/cotton pieces.
- 5. Iron a 1/4" hem all the way around the cotton lining piece.
- 6. Center the lining on the wool (see picture below) and pin into place.
- 7. Stitch the sides and the top of the lining to the wool, leaving the bottom open.
- 8. Cut out the chip board using the pattern.
- 9. Insert the chip board under the lining and stitch the bottom closed.
- 10. Fold in the sides of the envelope and the bottom of the envelope up, and pin into place.





- 11. Blanket Stitch the envelope edges following the photo. Be sure to leave it open.
  - 12. Add embellishment stitches as desired.
- 13. Fold the ribbon in half and, positioning the button on top, stitch them into place at the envelope point to finish.
